Here's a handy checklist to help you out.

With a little prep today, you'll be ready to use your plan as soon as it begins.

Access your digital health plan ID card

It's available whenever you need it on the **UnitedHealthcare® app** and at **myuhc.com®**—and you can show it at your doctor's office, clinic or anywhere benefits information needs to be shared. Add it to your smartphone's digital wallet for a secure way to store and access details about your plan.

Explore the UnitedHealthcare app

You'll see a variety of things you can do at your own pace as you transition into your new plan, which may include:

- Search for network providers
- Set up notification and communication preferences
- · Access on-demand, virtual assistance through the chat feature
- Start Transition of Care for ongoing treatment, if eligible
- · Manage your medications, if you have prescription drug coverage

Choose a network PCP

Even if your plan doesn't require you to select a network primary care provider (PCP),* it can be helpful to have one – as they understand your health needs and goals well. To find one, sign in on the **UnitedHealthcare app** and tap **Find Care**. Or, sign in at **myuhc.com** and select **Find Care & Costs**.

Make an appointment

Preventive care, such as annual wellness exams, certain recommended screenings and routine immunizations, is covered by most plans at no additional cost when you see network providers.
